Dear Governor Wolf:

I am extremely concerned about the proposed Mariner East 2 hazardous liquids pipeline that Sunoco plans to install in my community.

Sunoco's safety record is the worst in the industry. Their pipelines are known to leak and explode. A leak or explosion in our highly populated community would result in a very high number of casualties and property damage.

The Mariner East 2 is not a regular gas pipeline. The highly toxic and combustible liquid gases contents of this large high-pressure pipeline are colorless and odorless. They would cause asphyxiation within a few minutes. A devastating explosion would result if the gases were ignited by a source as simple as a cell phone, car engine, garage door opener or a doorbell.

Of particular concern is the pipeline's close proximity to an elementary school. It would be impossible to evacuate the 440 children in the event of a pipeline leak or rupture. This situation is unconscionable and completely unacceptable. Are we and our children to be sacrificed for Sunoco's profit?

I ask that you have the DEP open up another sixty day comment period once Sunoco completes the re-submission of their application.

I also ask that you hold a private meeting with members of Middletown Coalition for Community Safety (484-326-6444) so that you can get a better sense of our community's concerns.

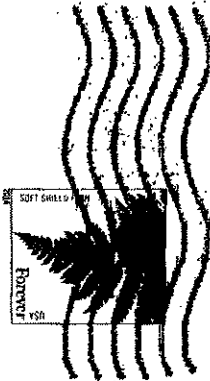
