It continued its work with communities throughout Pennsylvania to address the air quality and environmental impacts from a number of proposed natural gas transmission pipelines and pipeline expansions. Clean Air Council also continued to spearhead the Protect our Children coalition to prevent new natural gas fracking operations from being sited in close proximity to schools. Clean Air Council's I See Smoke campaign focused on pollution from wood-fired boilers. In Pittsburgh the Council, as part of a collaborative, pushed for Shenango Coke Works to clean up its emissions. Lastly, the 725,997 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ 4b (Code ) (Expenses \$ 4b) - Transportation Education: The Council continued to oversee the long-term development of the Cobbs Creek Connector multiuse trail in Southwest Philadelphia. It succeeded in placing one of the segments of this proposed trail on the region's Transportation Improvement Plan, which designates federal funding directly for the project. This past year the Council also publicly went live with its GoPhillyGo regional multi-modal mapping website tool to help people plan recreational trips without need for a car. It oversaw the repower of one tugboat and the replacement of eight drayage trucks, resulting in significant emission reductions for the Wilmington, Delaware region. Air Council encouraged Philadelphia employees to commute sustainably to 126,380 including grants of \$ ) (Expenses \$ ) (Revenue \$ 4c (Code 4c) - Energy Education: Clean Air Council continued to promote solar energy, wind energy, and energy efficiency. It filed a lawsuit in Pennsylvania against the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code Review and Advisory Council to pass the most efficient building codes available, which would result in 30% energy savings statewide. The Council remained active in the Exelon Corporation-Delmarva Power merger case and intervened in rate increase cases, involving utility companies PECO and PPL, to support greater energy efficiency and use of renewable energy.

This street festival, which aimed to educate the public on how to live more sustainably, took place in South Philadelphia's Headhouse Square. Thousands enjoyed the event which featured exhibitors offering environmental services or products; a green beer garden; "Green Innovators;" Kids' Corner; a rock-climbing wall; and live music from local artists such as West Philadelphia Orchestra and Ron Gallo. Additionally, the Council advocated for Pennsylvania to regulate methane emissions. At numerous community events throughout Pennsylvania the Council provided information to the public about global climate change and climate adaptation, particularly the health and environmental effects climate change is expected to have.
- 4e) Other Expenses (Expenses: \$153,443): Clean Air Council continued to educate people about indoor air quality and to maintain a repository of information on indoor air pollution. It oversaw a rebate program to pay for dry cleaners to upgrade their equipment to ones that are free of the toxic chemical perchloroethylene. It aimed to reduce tobacco smoke

pollution by working with public housing units to go smoke-free across

Pennsylvania. As part of its efforts to reduce waste, it advocated for a reduction in the use of plastic bags in Philadelphia. Lastly, it worked with economically disadvantaged neighborhoods in Philadelphia and Wilmington to address sources of pollution in close proximity to them.
