Supplemental Information

On September 9, 2012 Clean Air Council held the 7th Annual Greenfest Philly. This street festival, which aims to educate the public on how to live more sustainably, took place in South Philadelphia's Headhouse Square. New for 2012 were a "green beer garden" and a scavenger hunt that further educated attendees about exhibitors' green initiatives. Thousands enjoyed the event which featured exhibitors offering environmental services or products; "Green Innovators," which were a select group of start-up organizations with compelling missions of sustainability; a Kid's Zone; and live music. Clean Air Council held its 32nd Annual Run for Clean Air on April 20, 2013 on Martin Luther King, Jr. Drive near the Philadelphia Museum of Art. While the Run course was the same as in prior years, the accompanying Earth Day festival was set up in front of the Museum for the first time. New for 2013 was a Kid's Fun Run. With nearly 2,500 runners and walkers registered, the Run continued to be a popular event and the largest Earth Day race in the area. The race remained green certified and generated nearly zero waste. Also, participants who switched their electricity to 100% solar and wind ran for free. The two special events combined to raise about \$120,000 for the Council.
