4a (Code ) (Expenses \$ 588,849 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ Air Quality Education: Clean Air Council maintained its program to address the air quality impacts of Marcellus Shale natural gas extraction, processing, and transmission. In the past year the Council worked with communities throughout Pennsylvania to address the air quality and environmental impacts from eight proposed natural gas transmission pipelines and pipeline expansions. Clean Air Council also spearheaded the Protect our Children coalition, which works in Southwestern Pennsylvania to ensure new natural gas fracking operations are not sited in close proximity to school districts. Clean Air Council's I See Smoke campaign addresses the issue of pollution from wood-fired boiler. As part of the campaign, the Council produced an app allowing Pennsylvania residents to report on

4b (Code. ) (Expenses \$ 216,458 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ Transportation Education: The Council completed Final Design for the first segment of the Cobbs Creek Connector multiuse trail in Southwest Philadelphia. It began work on a new regional multimodal website tool to help people plan recreational trips without need for a car. It oversaw the retrofit of five diesel-powered construction vehicles through its Philadelphia Diesel Difference Program. Clean Air Council encouraged Philadelphia employees to commute sustainably to work through its Mobility Alternatives Program. And the Council partnered with Textizen to develop a system for citizens to inform city fleets via phone-based texting if their trucks are idling.

4c (Code. ) (Expenses \$ 163,699 including grants of \$ ) (Revenue \$ Environmental Health Education: Clean Air Council worked on a Health Impact Assessment report concerning Shell's proposed ethane cracker facility in Beaver County. The goal of the report is to analyze the health impacts that could result from the building of the planned cracker plant and to recommend ways to minimize these impacts. In Philadelphia the Council worked with low income communities to address issues of illegal short dumping and port-related truck traffic emissions and to develop an environmental hazard community health assessment. In Delaware the Council worked with residents of South Wilmington to address serious malodor issues coming from a compost facility. Ultimately the facility was closed.

On September 8, 2013 Clean Air Council held the 8th Annual Greenfest Philly. This street festival, which aimed to educate the public on how to live more sustainably, took place in South Philadelphia's Headhouse Square. New for 2013 were the Green Card, an all-inclusive festival package, and expansion of the festival site to include more of South Thousands enjoyed the event which featured exhibitors offering environmental services or products; "Green Innovators;" a Kids' Corner; and live music from well-known artists such as The Districts. Clean Air Council held its 33rd Annual Run for Clean Air on April 19, 2014. For the first time, the Run started and ended in front of the Art Museum. New for 2014 were run t-shirts made out of 100% recycled materials, tech shirts, and a sustainably brewed beer garden. With 2,000 participants the Run continued to be a popular event and the largest Earth Day race in the area. Lastly, the Council held its newest event, Dine Out For The Environment, on May 22, 2014. Dine Out was a citywide event highlighting the most sustainable restaurants in Philadelphia. A portion of all sales from the 13 participating restaurants that day were donated to the Council. The three special events combined to raise about \$179,000 for the Council.
