# Description of Responsibilities:

The employee will work closely with members of Clean Air Council's legal and organizing teams, as well as the Council's Political Director and Executive Director/Chief Counsel, on a full range of cutting-edge environmental policy and advocacy efforts in Pennsylvania and at the federal level. The employee will focus on statewide advocacy, public education, and youth engagement about fossil fuel and petrochemical issues and alternatives. The employee may collaborate with Clean Air Council's partners, state clean energy coalitions, and a wide network of allies, including: the environmental community; frontline and environmental justice groups; consumer and low-income advocates; labor; the faith community; clean energy businesses; utilities; state and local decision makers; and elected officials.
