Eastwick is at high risk for flooding from the Schuylkill and Delaware Rivers, and Darby and Cobbs Creeks. The area has already been affected by many significant storm events, including Hurricane Floyd and Tropical Storm Isaias.



Local Air Quality

Eastwick has been affected by nearby air pollution from the airport and local industrial sites. This pollution can enter your body causing health issues especially for people with underlying health conditions, like asthma.




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
