Are you a South or Southwest Philadelphia resident concerned about air pollution and public health? Now you can host a FREE air monitor at your home, business, or organization. Through this air monitoring program, you will be able to see data from your monitor and your neighbors' monitors in real time online and on a smartphone app. Residents who host an air monitor will receive a \$50 gift card as thanks. All data collected from air monitors will be publicly available. This data, alongside health data collected from other programs, will be used to

advance advocacy efforts to mitigate pollution impacts and reduce harm to our communities.

Clean Air Council has received funding from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to install outdoor air monitors at homes, businesses, and organizations throughout South and Southwest Philadelphia. 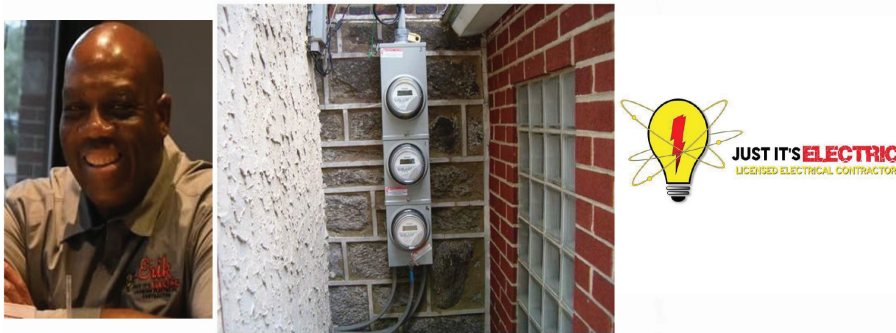
SEPTA Working on Making Trolley Stops More Accessible



As part of SEPTA's 12-year capital investment program, they are making stations accessible, acquiring new vehicles, investing in communications, and upgrading services for their buses, Metro, and rail.

SEPTA trolleys are currently not accessible to people with disabilities. SEPTA aims to make riding trolleys accessible, fast, and easy. Renovations are needed to remove barriers to access for all riders—those with disabilities, seniors, small children, and their families.
