In celebration of Women's History Month, two West Philadelphia-based organizations, Tiny Trekkers and UC Green, are teaming up to host a special nature walk on Saturday, March 22 from 10:00-12:00pm at Whitby Meadows, located at Cobbs Creek Parkway and Whitby Avenue. This event offers a unique opportunity for families, nature enthusiasts, and anyone interested in learning about both environmentalism and the important contributions of women throughout history. The walk will center on the theme of trees and their significance in the environment, while also highlighting the lives and achievements of historical women who have made a lasting impact in the field of environmentalism.

The event is a collaboration between two key members of the Cobbs Creek Watershed Coalition: Dominique London of UC Green and Elaine Wells of Tiny Trekkers. The Cobbs Creek Watershed Coalition is a collective of stewards who promote the care of and safe access to the Cobbs Creek Watershed extending from past City Ave to Southwest. By coming together, these organizations are expanding their reach and enhancing the programming available to local residents, making it an exciting opportunity to increase community engagement. This collaboration is especially important in fostering connections between local residents and the natural world, while also inspiring future generations to take an active role in environmental stewardship.

Whitby Meadows serves as a perfect backdrop for this nature walk, offering a beautiful setting for participants to explore the local flora and fauna. The walk will not only provide valuable insights into the ecological significance of trees but also educate attendees about the historical women who have paved the way for environmental activism. Through the exploration of their stories, participants will gain a deeper understanding of how women have shaped the environmental landscape, both locally and globally.

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INDEGO BIKE SHARE EXPANSION TO COBBS CREEK

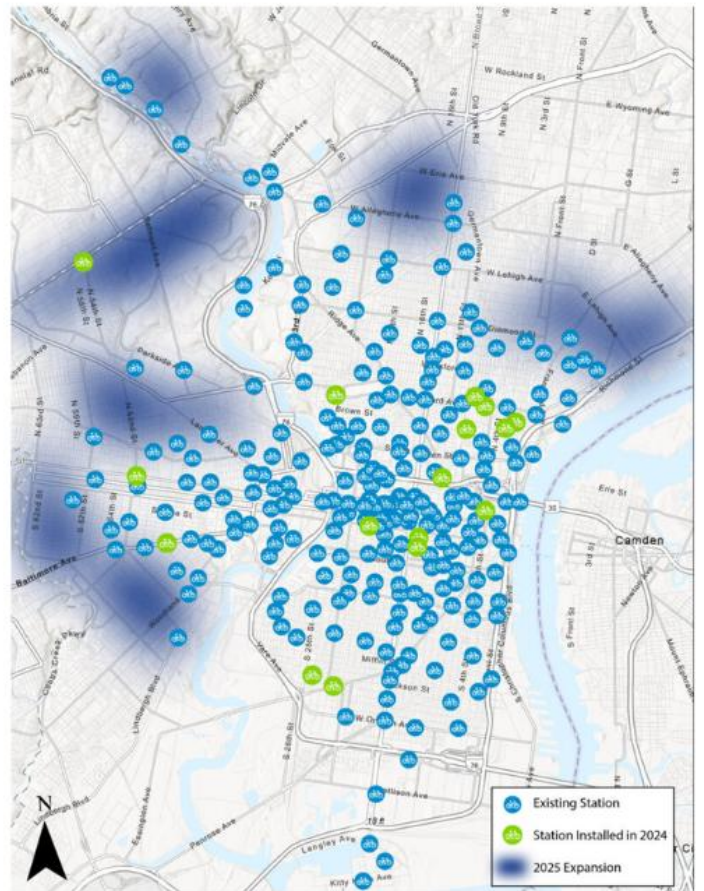
Indego is Philadelphia's bike share system which offers over 2,000 public bike rentals at stations located throughout the city. Single rides and monthly and annual passes are available for both bicycles and and electric bikes.

Plans to expand Indego in 2025 are underway and Cobbs Creek is one of the three new areas that will receive bike stations. Cobbs Creek was selected based on a variety of factors, including Indego's commitment to equity, increasing access to low-income communities and communities of color, proximity to green spaces and educational institutions, and connections to transit hubs.

Indego plans to add 40 new stations and 400 electric bikes to their system by the end of 2025. Cobbs Creek neighbors can help inform where stations will be located by using the Suggest a Station tool to recommend future sites of bike share stations. This is a great opportunity to help inform a transportation and recreation resource for your neighborhood. To find out more and suggest a station use the QR code below.

Cobbs Creek Trail partners and stakeholders identified a few potential locations for stations along Cobbs Trail including Market St (El stop), Spruce/Walnut(Laura Sims Skate House/Cobbs Creek Rec Center), Catherine St (Cobbs Creek Environmental Center) and Baltimore Ave (Cobbs Library).
